\*\* Master's in Biomedical Sciences Degree students receive \$0 computer allowance and reduced books/supplies allowance upon matriculation into the MD program.

\*\*\* Loan fees are calculated on a case-by-case and based on the federal Direct Unsubsidized loan eligibility in this program. The 2022-23 Direct Unsubsidized loan origination fee is 1.057%.

\*\*\*\* The cost of health insurance premiums (for the student only) may be added on a case-by-case basis for students who submit an Appeal for Individual Budget Increase Form with proof of payment. Students are required to carry health insurance throughout their degree program that provides coverage for preventive, diagnostic, therapeutic, and mental health services. Students may satisfy this requirement using the government healthcare exchange, Medicaid insurance, or private health insurance under a parent plan, spouse/partner plan, or separate individual/family health insurance plan.
